ORDER

1. In the Regulation of B.Tech Degree Course implemented from 2007 admission, Vide paper read (1) above, sub clause (v) of clause 11 Procedure for completion of the course states that "A candidate should complete the programme and pass all Examinations within seven (7) years (Six years in case of L ES) since his/her admission to B.Tech Programme".
2. The Syndicate of the University, Vide paper read (2) above, fixed Re-registration fee of Rs.4000/- (Rupees Four Thousand only) for B.Tech Students of 2007 admission onwards and accordingly, the University Order was issued Vide paper (3) above.
3. Subsequently, the Syndicate of the University , Vide paper read (4) above, resolved to enhance 5% increase in the existing fees/charges for all services w.e.f 01.04.2018, as per the letter from the Principal Secretary, Finance, Kerala Government and the Re-registration fee of Rs.4000/- was enhanced to Rs.4200/- (Rupees Four Thousand and Two Hundred only).
4. Meanwhile, as representations were received from the students of B.Tech 2011 admission Batch, requesting to permit them to register for the examinations as they have exceeded the seven years of course as stipulated in the regulation, the Academic 'D' Section, Vide paper read (5) above, requested to take necessary action.

5. The matter was placed before the Board of Studies in Engineering (UG) held on 15.11.2018 and vide paper read (6) above, the Board considered the matter and recommended to allow B.Tech 2011 admission Batch students to Re-register for the course relaxing sub clause (v) of clause 11 of B.Tech Regulations and permitted to appear for the Examinations, up to April/May 2019.

6. The Vice-Chancellor, after considering the matter in detail and in exercise of the powers of the Academic Council conferred under Section 11 (1) of Kannur University Act 1996 and all other enabling provisions read together with, issued the following orders.

The students of B.Tech 2011 admission batch (New Scheme) are permitted to Re-register for the course, by levying Re-registration fees of Rs.4200/- (Rupees Four Thousand and Two Hundred only) and appear for examinations up to April/May 2019, relaxing sub clause (v) of clause 11 of B.Tech Regulations, implemented w.e.f 2007 admission.

7. The U.O read (1) above, stands modified to this extent.

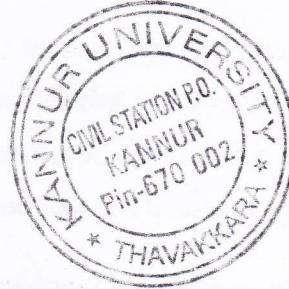


