ORDER

1. As per paper read (1) above, candidates of B.Tech (Regular/ Part time) of 2010-14 batch who could not complete their course within the stipulated period as per the regulation of B Tech Programmes, and who could not attend the already granted mercy chance examinations due to their official commitments/ transfer, Covid related inconveniences etc., requested to grant one more chance for re registration to attend B.Tech Examination till April 2023, as a special case.

2. As per paper read (2) above, vide item No. 2022.279, the Syndicate considered the aforesaid request and resolved to authorise Prof. Maheshkumar. P, Member, Syndicate, to study the matter in detail and to submit recommendations to the Vice Chancellor regarding the approximate number of students and number of examinations pending to be conducted. Meanwhile, candidates of B.Tech programmes of other batches also approached University for granting permission to attend mercy chance examination and to complete the programme

3. As per paper read (3) above, Dr. Mahesh Kumar P, Member, Syndicate after a detailed study and discussion with Chairperson BoS of various Subjects, authorities of other Universities, and also after analysis of data regarding registration and attendance of ongoing series of examinations, submitted the report with the following recommendations.

1. Recommended to conduct B.Tech Examinations as One last Mercy Chance for all batches from 2007 to 2014 admission. The proposed series of examinations will commence only after completing the entire formalities of current series of examinations.

2. Recommended to

(a) Stop using Engineering colleges for conducting theory examinations, by utilising suitable venue at University Campus, Thavakkara and to depute University Staff for invigilation duty

(b) To conduct all practical examination at a Single Engineering College- ie: Govt. College of Engineering, Kannur. Students from other Colleges can approach Govt. College of Engineering, Kannur to familiarize the laboratories well before the examinations.

4. As per paper read (4) above, Syndicate approved the the aforesaid report submitted by Dr. Mahesh Kumar.P, Member Syndicate regarding feasibility study on continuation of conduct of B.Tech Examination for one more chance.

5. Further, the Vice Chancellor ordered to collect same Re-registration fee of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only) and Rs.500/- for each paper, as that was levied for previous mercy chance

examinations, as per paper read(5) above.

6. The Vice Chancellor, after considering the matter in detail and in exercise of the powers of the Academic Council conferred under Section 11(1) Chapter III of Kannur University Act 1996, issued the following orders, and to report to the Academic Council.

- (i) Permission is granted for the conduct of One last Mercy Chance examination for B.Tech candidates of all batches from 2007 to 2014 admission (Regular and Part Time), after levying a Re-Registration fee of Rs.5000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only) and Rs. 500/- (Rupees Five Hundred only) for each paper.
 - (ii) The aforesaid One last Mercy Chance examination shall be conducted only after completing the entire formalities of current series of examinations.
 - (iii) Suitable venue at University Campus, Thavakkara shall be utilized for conducting theory examinations and University Staff shall be deputed for invigilation duty.
 - (iv) All the practical examination shall be conducted at Govt College of Engineering, Kannur. Students from other Colleges shall approach Govt College of Engineering, Kannur to familiarize the laboratories well before the examinations.
6. Examination Branch shall initiate further steps to notify the examinations accordingly.
