ORDER

As per the paper read above, criteria for admission to PG Programme under the University has been revised and as per that the eligibility criteria for admission to MCA was U.G. Degree in B.Tech, BCA, B.Sc/B.Com with Mathematics or Statistics as core or complementary courses/subsidiaries, with not less than 50% marks or equivalent G.P.A, in addition to the minimum requirement of overall CGPA 1.5 under CCSS.

2. As per the paper read(2) above, Additional Chief Secretary to Government has forwarded the minutes of the meeting held on 25.05.2013 to adopt uniform academic qualification for admission to MCA course to be conducted under the Universities in Kerala.

3. The matter was considered by the Academic Council in its meeting held on 16.01.2014 and resolved to adopt the uniform qualification/academic eligibility proposed by the Government of Kerala for admission to MCA Programme under Kannur University with effect from 2014 admission.

4. After considering the matter in detail, the Vice Chancellor has accorded sanction for implementing the eligibility criteria for admission to MCA Programme offered in University Department/Centres and affiliated Colleges as recommended by the Higher Education Department and approved by the Academic Council with effect from 2014 admission as detailed below,

“Candidates should have studied a Degree course with minimum 3 year duration(after 10+2) with Mathematics/ Statistics/ Computer Science/ Computer Application/ Engineering and Technology as a Main / Subsidiary/ Core/complementary subject at the Degree level. The candidate should have secured a minimum aggregate of 50% marks or equivalent grade in their degree examination. For SEBC and Physically Handicapped candidates the aggregate marks required is 45%. For SC and ST a minimum pass in the Degree examination is sufficient.”

5. Therefore orders are issued accordingly.

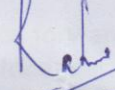
